



RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

Hope House Colorado's Residential Program offers a safe, stable home for teen moms and their children who are participating in our programs and who have become homeless or are living in an unsafe environment. Our 12-bedroom home provides our moms up to a week of respite care, up to nine months of transitional housing or up to two years of comprehensive programming. While at the house, our moms are engaged and challenged through an individual growth plan, learning to incorporate healthy routines into daily life while living with their children and their peers in a safe, supportive environment.

THE HOUSE

Our 5,500 square-foot Residential House, designed to be warm and welcoming, offers:

- Safe housing for up to 8 teen moms and their children (dependent on age of each teen moms' children).
- Twelve bedrooms, providing each teen mom a room separate from her child(ren)'s room.
- Multifunction learning center to host life skills classes, parenting classes, counseling sessions, computers and a quiet study area
- A playroom for the children
- Extended dining area for family-style meals



Meet Ckara

Ckara became pregnant with her daughter La'Jaya when she was 17 years old. Originally from Pennsylvania, Ckara moved to Colorado to live with a family member and was encouraged to check out Hope House Colorado as a place that could support her as a teen mom. Ckara applied and quickly began attending classes and events. When her living situation got worse, Ckara applied for the residential house and moved in September of 2021. Living at the house has offered a healthier environment for La'Jaya and a place where Ckara can learn to become independent.

While a resident at the house, Ckara has earned her GED and learner's permit. She is now working hard to become a nurse. She is also busy with parenting and personal growth classes at Hope House.

Ckara enjoys cooking and eating with the other moms living at the house, and spending time with the kids from Hope House.
