



## RESIDENTIAL PROGRAM

As metro-Denver's only Residential Program for parenting teen moms, Hope House Colorado's Residential Program offers a safe, stable home for teen moms and their children who are participating in our programs and who have become homeless or are living in an unsafe environment. Our 12-bedroom home provides our moms with respite care, up to nine months of transitional housing or up to two years of comprehensive programming.

### Our Residential House offers:

- Safe housing for approximately six teen moms and their children.
- A playroom for children.
- Extended dining area for family-style meals.
- Access to the Resource Center that provides free self-sufficiency classes, a quiet Learning Lab, access to meals in the Dining Hall, an Early Learning & School Age Program and more.

## HOUSING SERVICES

The Housing Support Program is responsible for assisting teen moms with obtaining stable housing and driving growth in the housing domain of the Self-Sufficiency Rubric. Housing services include assisting teen moms to understand the different housing options that will best meet their current needs; guiding them through filling out housing applications; assisting them with budgeting and obtaining vital documentation; landlord management, eviction mitigation and habitability support as needed. The program also assists with deposits and first month's rent to help moms secure stable and safe housing.
